**FINAL ORDER**


The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Travis Noah Levon Privott (“Applicant”), signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance (“Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, which grants Applicant a resident producer license and places Applicant on probation for two (2) years for having a 2014 felony conviction for Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner as follows:

1. Applicant shall be granted a resident producer license on a probationary basis for two (2) years.
2. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code shall result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.

**AGREED ENTRY**

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Travis Noah Levon Privott ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2018, Applicant submitted an application for resident producer licensure;

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant disclosed an April 21, 2014 conviction for Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon, Class D Felony, from the State of Delaware;

WHEREAS, Applicant's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), which states that the commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation for having been convicted of a felony;


WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:



1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Applicant's license shall be granted and Applicant placed on probation for two (2) years, beginning the date the Commissioner executes the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
6. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
7. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation(s).
8. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
9. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
10. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

11. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
12. Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.

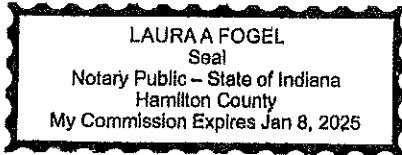
