2. Applicant shall pay civil penalty of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) to the

Department within thirty (30) days after the date of this Final Order.

3. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.

AGREED ENTRY

Mack ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, on September 09, 2018, Applicant submitted an application for an Indiana resident producer license:

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant failed to disclose a 2018 misdemeanor conviction for Invasion of Privacy;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states, in part, that the Commissioner may levy a civil penalty and place a producer on probation for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application;

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this
 Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Applicant's Indiana resident producer's license shall be granted, and Applicant placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
- 6. The two (2) year probationary period shall begin upon the date of the issuance of the Final Order in this matter.
- 7. Applicant shall pay a civil penalty of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) to the Department within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
- 8. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.

- Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress,
 threat or undue influence.
- 11. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- 12. Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
