FINAL ORDER

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”) by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Adam Dodd (“Applicant”), signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, which grants Applicant a resident producer license on a probationary basis for one (1) year due to a misdemeanor conviction for Battery, a Class A Misdemeanor, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry, as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner:

1. Applicant’s resident producer license shall be granted and Applicant placed on probation for one (1) year beginning the date of this Final Order.

2. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.

AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Adam Dodd ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Applicant is applying for a resident producer license, with application number 671715;

WHEREAS, on said application, Applicant disclosed a March 13, 2013 conviction for Battery, a Class A Misdemeanor;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states, in part, that the Commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

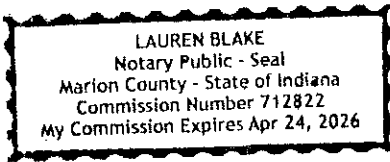
IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Applicant's license shall be granted and Applicant placed on probation for a period of one (1) year, beginning the date the Commissioner executes the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
6. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
7. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation(s).
8. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
9. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
10. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.




