FINAL ORDER

The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Samantha Carpenter (“Applicant”), an applicant for an Indiana resident producer license, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, which grants Applicant a two (2) year probationary resident producer license for having a 2013 misdemeanor conviction, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry, attached, as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner as follows:

1. Applicant's Indiana resident producer license shall be granted and placed on probation for a period of two (2) years beginning upon the issuance of this final order; during the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of the Applicant's license.
2. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.

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AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Samantha Carpenter (“Applicant”), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”).

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2018, Applicant submitted an application for an Indiana resident producer license;

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant disclosed a 2013 conviction for conversion, a Class A Misdemeanor;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states, in part, that the Commissioner may place a producer on probation for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;


WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Applicant's Indiana resident producer's license shall be granted and placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
6. The two (2) year probationary period shall begin upon the date of the issuance of the Final Order in this matter.
7. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
8. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
9. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
10. Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
