This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Colin Willis ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2018, Applicant submitted an application for a resident producer's license;

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant disclosed two (2) convictions for Disorderly Conduct, a Class B Misdemeanor, and one (1) conviction for Harassment, an Unclassified Misdemeanor, all from October 3, 2011 in the State of Wisconsin;

WHEREAS, Applicant's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), which states, in part, that the commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation for

using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- 3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Applicant's license shall be granted, and Applicant placed on probation for two (2) years, during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
- 6. The two (2) year probationary period will begin the date the Commissioner enters the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
- 7. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- 8. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress,
 threat or undue influence.

- Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that 10. presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement 11. will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
