FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND RECOMMENDED ORDER

Administrative Law Judge Reuben B. Hill ("ALJ"), having heard, reviewed and considered all of the evidence, will now render a decision concerning the matter of Daniel Luttrell ("Applicant"). This matter came on to be heard by the ALJ on November 14, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. at the Indiana Department of Insurance at 311 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana.

The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department") was represented by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs. Applicant appeared in person and without counsel.

Testimony was heard, and exhibits were received into evidence.

Based upon the evidence presented at said hearing, the ALJ now makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and issues this Recommended Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Applicant applied for a Resident Producer License on August 15, 2018.
- On his application disclosed a prior criminal conviction for Harassment, a Class A
 Misdemeanor, from August 6, 2015 in the State of Oregon. (Applicant's Exhibit A)
- 3. This conviction was pursuant to a plea agreement, wherein Applicant pleaded guilty to unlawfully and intentionally harassing or annoying the victim by subjecting her to offensive physical contact. (Department's Exhibit 1) (Applicant's Exhibit A)
- 4. At the hearing, the ALJ took judicial notice of Oregon Revised Statute 166.065.
- 5. Under Oregon Revised Statute 166.065, Harassment is a Class B Misdemeanor, which enhances to a Class A Misdemeanor if the victim of the offense is a family or household member.
- 6. As a result of the plea agreement, the lead charge of Assault in the Fourth Degree, an act which "constituted an act of domestic violence", was dismissed. (Applicant's Exhibit A)
- Applicant testified that the victim was his live-in fiance', and the battery occurred when
 his fiance' attempted to force a conversation he did not want to have. (Hearing
 Transcript pp. 33, 47)
- 8. Applicant admitted eleven (11) exhibits at the hearing. Applicant's Exhibit A is a copy of the Judgment of Conviction from the 2015 Harassment conviction. Applicant's Exhibits B-F pertain to a restricted Producer License Application obtained on May 10, 2018 in the State of California. Applicant's Exhibit G is the Commissioner's Preliminary

- Order of License Denial entered September 21, 2018. Applicant's H-K are character reference letters from four (4) of Applicant's friends.
- Applicant testified his California restricted license was granted after he moved to Indiana,
 and he surrendered it in August 2018. (Hearing Transcript pp.21, 36)
- 10. Conclusions of Law that can be adopted as Findings of Fact are hereby incorporated herein as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over both the subject matter and the parties to this action.
- 2. This hearing was held in compliance with the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act of the Indiana Code.
- 3. Indiana Code 21-1-15.6-12 states that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an Insurance Producer License due to a number of factors.
- 4. Specifically, Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) allows the Commissioner to deny an Insurance Producer License for using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 5. Applicant's 2015 harassment conviction, on its face, demonstrates coercive conduct in violation of Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8).
- 6. Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-14(c) states that the person requesting an agency take action has the burden of persuasion and the burden of going forward. Applicant is requesting that the Department issue him a Resident Producer License and, therefore, bears the burden.

- 7. Pursuant to Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(d), a hearing was held to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's decision was unreasonable.
- Findings of Fact that can be adopted as Conclusions of Law are hereby incorporated herein as such.

RECOMMENDED ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED:

In consideration of the foregoing Findings of Fact and the Conclusions of Law as stated, the Administrative Law Judge now recommends to the **Commissioner of Insurance** the following:

The refusal to issue Applicant an Indiana Resident Producer License shall be
 AFFIRMED and Applicant shall not re-apply for licensure for one (1) year from the
 date of the Final Order in this matter.

PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Daniel A. Luttrell ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on August 15, 2018.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met

the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his 2015 conviction for Harassment, a Class A Misdemeanor, out of Oregon.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his misdemeanor conviction. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
