WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed nonresident insurance producer, holding license number 3257629 since July 20, 2017;

WHEREAS, Respondent was convicted of Theft, a Class 1 Misdemeanor, in the State of Virginia on August 16, 2018, upon pleading guilty at her initial hearing;

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2018, Respondent timely notified the Department of the charges and conviction;

WHEREAS, Respondent's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), which states that a producer shall not use fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or

demonstrate incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
- 6. Respondent shall be placed on probation for two (2) years, during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Respondent's license.
- 7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- 8. Should additional violations manifest, the Department will take further administrative action for the new violation(s).

- Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands 9. its terms.
- Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to 10. duress, threat or undue influence.
