PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Glynis A. Snell ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on October 02, 2018.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for having an insurance producer's license or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.
- 5. Following a review a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to her failure to disclose her December 08, 2017 License Denial by the Indiana Department of Insurance and her July 10, 2018 Revocation Order by the Louisiana Department of Insurance.
- 6. Following a review materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to her July 10, 2018 Order of Revocation by the Louisiana Department of Insurance, her December 02, 2010 Order of Suspension by the Florida Department of Financial Services, and her November 29, 2012 License Denial by the Wisconsin Office of the Commissioner of Insurance.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), for having had licenses suspended, denied, or revoked, and for her failure to disclose two (2) administrative actions on an application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
