PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Eugene D. Zangari ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies

Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his July 13, 2017 Consent Order issued by the Pennsylvania

Insurance Department and the surrounding facts and circumstances.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the

Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of

the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due Applicant's Pennsylvania Consent Order and

the surrounding facts and circumstances. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one

(1) year from the date of this order.
