PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Stacy Ridenour (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for nonresident producer’s licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on October 22, 2018.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) authorizes the Commissioner to refuse to issue a producer’s license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to her failure to disclose a conviction for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a 4th Degree Misdemeanor, from August 31, 2007 in the State of Ohio, and a 2016 Florida producer license denial on her application for licensure.
5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for failing to disclose her full criminal history and a prior license denial on her application for licensure.
