## PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Stacy Ridenour ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for nonresident producer's licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on October 22, 2018.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) authorizes the Commissioner to refuse to issue a producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to her failure to disclose a conviction for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Misdemeanor, from August 31, 2007 in the State of Ohio, and a 2016 Florida

producer license denial on her application for licensure.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby

DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for failing to disclose her full criminal history and a prior license denial on her application for licensure.
