Dobbs, and Melissa Hall ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2018, Applicant submitted an application for a resident producer's license;

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant disclosed a pending charge of Maintaining a Common Nuisance, a Level 6 Felony, from June 4, 2018;

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2018, Applicant entered into a six (6) month felony pretrial diversion agreement and the charge against her may be dismissed on or around March 11, 2019;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) states that the commissioner may deny an insurance producer's license or place an insurance producer on probation for having been convicted of a felony;

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this
 Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- 3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Applicant's license shall be granted, and Applicant placed on probation for two (2) years, during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
- 6. Applicant must notify the Department of the outcome of the diversion program and pending felony charge in Cause Number 27C01-1806-F6-000299 within thirty (30) days after charges are dismissed or prosecution reinstated.
- 7. The Department reserves the right to seek additional administrative action based on the results of the pending criminal case.
- 8. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- 9. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

- 10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- 11. Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
