**FINAL ORDER**


The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”) by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Elizabeth Schrock (“Respondent”), signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, which suspends Respondent’s resident producer license for failing to timely report criminal charges to the Department until such time as she successfully completes the terms of her pretrial diversion program, including anger management counseling, the criminal charge against her has been dismissed, and she has submitted proof to the Department of the same, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry, as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner:

1. Respondent's resident producer license shall be suspended, effective the date of this order, until she has successfully completed the terms of her pretrial diversion program, including anger management counseling, the criminal charge against her has been dismissed, and she has submitted proof to the Department of the same.

AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Elizabeth Schrock ("Respondent"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent is a resident insurance producer, holding license number 3169527 since July 11, 2016;

WHEREAS, on a November 5, 2018 application to add a qualification to her licensure, Respondent disclosed a May 22, 2018 charge for Domestic Battery, a Class A Misdemeanor;

WHEREAS, Respondent had appeared for an initial hearing for this criminal charge on May 25, 2018;

WHEREAS, Respondent has entered a pretrial diversion program to resolve these criminal charges and the charges may be dismissed on or around September 13, 2019;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) states, in part, that the Commissioner may suspend or revoke an insurance producer's license for violating an insurance law;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b) states that not more than thirty (30) days after an initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states, in part, that the Commissioner may suspend or revoke an insurance producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.


IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent's license shall be suspended, beginning the date the Commissioner executes the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry, until Respondent has successfully completed the terms of her pretrial diversion program, including anger


management counseling, the criminal charge against her has been dismissed, and she has submitted proof to the Department of the same.

6. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation(s).
7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
8. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
9. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
