PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Pamela S. McMillan ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on July 22, 2013, which was approved.
- 2. Applicant previously held her Indiana nonresident producer licensure, under license number 891547, from July 27, 2013 until January 31, 2016.
- Applicant filed an application to reactivate her nonresident license with the Commissioner on November 07, 2018.
- 4. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.

- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 7. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to her September 14, 2007 conviction for Conspiracy to Commit Distribution of Marijuana to a Minor, a Fourth Degree Felony, out of the State of New Mexico, and her failure to disclose the same on her July 22, 2013 application for licensure.
- 8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to her felony conviction and her failure to disclose it on an application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
