**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jesse A. McGriff (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for resident producer’s licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on January 5, 2019.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) authorizes the Commissioner to refuse to issue a producer’s license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana


Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to his failure to disclose criminal charges of Battery Against a Public Safety Official, a Level 6 Felony, and Possession of Marijuana, a Class B Misdemeanor, currently pending against Applicant in the Tipton County Circuit Court.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for failing to disclose pending criminal charges on his application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
