**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jessica Delisca ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant previously held Indiana nonresident producer licensure, under license number 839918, from September 17, 2012 through October 31, 2014.
2. Applicant filed an application to reinstate her nonresident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on January 18, 2019.
3. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.


5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) provides, in part, that the commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating an insurance law.
7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-7(a) is an insurance law that states a producer shall report to the commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.
8. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to a December 10, 2013 State of Michigan Department of Insurance and Financial Services Final Decision to revoke Applicant's Michigan nonresident producer license.
9. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of their application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to failing to disclose a December 10, 2013 State of Michigan Department of Insurance and Financial Services Final Decision to revoke Applicant's Michigan nonresident producer license.

10. Following a review of material submitted by Applicant in support of their application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) and 27-1-15.6-17(a), due to failing to timely report a December 10, 2013 State of Michigan Department of Insurance and Financial Services Final Decision to revoke Applicant's nonresident producer license while previously holding Indiana nonresident producer licensure.
11. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for failing to disclose an administrative action in an application for licensure, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) for having had a license revoked in the state of Michigan, and pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) and 27-1-15.6-17(a) for failing to timely disclose the same administrative action while previously licensed with the Department.
