## PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Reginald Porter ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
   Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on February 22, 2019.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.

- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 6. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to his pending criminal charge of Operating as a Habitual Traffic Violator, a Level 6 Felony, from January 26, 2018.
- 7. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to his September 11, 2015 conviction for Resisting Law Enforcement, a Level 6 Felony, and July 27, 2017 conviction for Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated with a Prior Conviction, a Level 6 Felony.
- 8. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his November 13, 2013 conviction for Carrying a Handgun Without a License, a Class A Misdemeanor, September 14, 2000 conviction for Criminal Recklessness Hazing, a Class B Misdemeanor, and September 14, 2000 conviction for Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury, a Class A Misdemeanor.
- 9. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the

Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his criminal history and failure to disclose same.
