PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jaime Lynn Willis. ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on April 1, 2019.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.

- 5. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to Applicant's May 25, 2005 conviction for Battery, a Class D Felony, and failure to disclose same on her application for licensure.
- 6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to Applicant's felony conviction and failure to disclose same on her application for licensure.
