**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Teyone Lillard, Sr. (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on April 4, 2019.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices,

or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

5. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to Applicant's failure to report multiple convictions on his application for licensure, which include, a June 9, 2006 conviction for Minor Consumption, a Class C Misdemeanor, two convictions from August 31, 2006 for Minor Consumption, a Class C Misdemeanor, December 14, 2006 conviction for Resisting Law Enforcement, a Class A Misdemeanor, May 27, 2008 conviction for Conversion, a Class A Misdemeanor, and November 21, 2017 conviction for Leaving the Scene of an Accident, a Class B Misdemeanor.
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to Applicant's failure to disclose multiple criminal convictions on his application for licensure.
