PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Kyle Hallberg ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on June 25, 2019.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

- 5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of their application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his November 19, 2013 convictions for Resisting Law Enforcement, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury, a Class A Misdemeanor.
- 6. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to Applicant's failure to disclose a March 8, 2019 State of Indiana License Denial on his application for licensure.
- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his criminal history and failure to disclose a previous license denial on his application for licensure.

Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
