PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Steven Vigil Johnson ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for a nonresident insurance producer's license with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on October 11, 2019.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest

- practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
- 6. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to failing to disclose a July 23, 2013 Arizona State Board of Technical Registration Consent Order resulting in the voluntary revocation of his Arizona Home Inspector License and a September 30, 2015 California Department of Insurance License Denial for failing to disclose the same.
- 7. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his July 23, 2013 Arizona State Board of Technical Registration Consent Order resulting in the voluntary revocation of his Arizona Home Inspector License for failing to meet the Standards of Practice for Arizona Home Inspectors by failing to adequately address several areas of a home in question.
- 8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for failing to disclose administrative actions in an application for licensure, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) for having had licenses revoked and denied, and pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) for the nature of his home inspector license revocation.
