## PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq*. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Cindy Cedeno ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application to reactivate her nonresident producer's licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on January 31, 2020.
- 2. Respondent formerly held a nonresident producer license number 3130570 from December 15, 2015 until January 12, 2018, when her license was suspended by the Commissioner for one (1) year, and she was required to pay a \$500 civil penalty, for representing herself as a state of Indiana Department of Insurance employee during a telephone sales call, under cause number 16473-AG17-1025-202.

- 3. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 6. Following a review of public records and documents submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), due to Applicant fraudulently representing herself as an employee of the state of Indiana Department of Insurance during an insurance sales call, and due to Applicant's revocation of her Louisiana nonresident producer's license.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three

  (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written

  demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the

  reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for reactivation of her nonresident producer license is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), due to Applicant fraudulently identifying herself as an employee of the state of Indiana, and due to Applicant's Louisiana's revocation of her nonresident producer's license. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
