PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jordan Alexandria Crisler ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on February 20, 2020.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices,

or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

5. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to her February 21, 2018, conviction for Battery, a Class B Misdemeanor, and for her failure to provide the Department with complete information regarding her conviction.

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to her criminal conviction, which includes a misdemeanor conviction for battery, and for her failure to provide the Department with complete information regarding her conviction. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
