PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Richard Simmons ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on May 22, 2019.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant and a review of public records, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully

met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to Applicant's criminal history, which includes a conviction from March 28, 2005, for Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver, a Class 4 Felony, in the State of Illinois.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to Applicant's criminal history, which includes a felony conviction. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
