PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jasmine M. Spaulding (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on April 20, 2020.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer’s license for having been convicted of a felony.
4. Following a review of public records, and a review of documentation submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to the following criminal convictions:


- a. 2010 Possession of Paraphernalia, a Class D Felony;
- b. 2012 Prostitution With a Prior Conviction, a Class D Felony;
- c. 2017 Unlawful Possession of a Syringe, a Level 6 Felony;
- d. 2018 Prostitution With a Prior Conviction, a Level 6 Felony;
- e. 2018 Unlawful Possession of a Syringe, a Level 6 Felony; and
- f. 2018 Unlawful Possession of a Syringe, a Level 6 Felony.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to Applicant's felony convictions. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
