## PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Anthony J. Saviano ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for temporary resident insurance producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on June 12, 2020.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) states that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 6. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to Applicant's criminal history, which includes having a felony conviction from September 29, 2014, for Receiving Stolen Property, a Class D Felony, in the State of Indiana, and for his failure to disclose it on his application.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to Applicant's criminal history, which includes having a felony conviction, and for his failure to disclose it on his application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
