ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq., and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Patrizzia Simpson, ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Respondent is a licensed nonresident insurance producer holding license number 3354197 since July 12, 2018 ("Respondent's license").
 - 2. Respondent's license expires on September 30, 2020.
- 3. On or about March 27, 2020, the Department received notification of the termination for cause of Respondent by Allstate Insurance Company ("Allstate").
- 4. According to Allstate, Respondent falsified or manipulated customer information on applications for insurance to improperly apply discounts.
- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest

practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of

the reason for the nonrenewal of her license. This Order serves as that notice.

7. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-

1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty-three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a

written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this

action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's

written demand.

8. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the

aforementioned authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office

of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside

over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more information to

begin the administrative process.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies

Respondent that her license shall not be renewed due to dishonest practices and intentionally

misrepresenting the terms of an insurance policy.
