PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to David J. Jackson & Company, LLC ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant previously held an Indiana nonresident producer organization licensure, under license number 1038273, from May 28, 2015 through May 31, 2019, when they failed to renew.
- Applicant filed an application to reinstate their nonresident producer organization licensure
 with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on June
 17, 2020.
- 3. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.

- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
- 6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating an insurance law.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(a) is an insurance law that states a producer shall report to the Commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.
- 8. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to Applicant failing to disclose an administrative action, specifically, a September 23, 2019 Wisconsin License Revocation on Applicant's application for licensure.
- 9. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to having an administrative action involving a

license revocation, specifically, Applicant's September 23, 2019 Wisconsin License Revocation.

10. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) and 27-1-15.6-17(a), due to Applicant failing to timely report a June 18, 2018 Virginia License Revocation to the Department within thirty (30) days of the final disposition while Applicant was previously licensed in Indiana.

11. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for failing to disclose an administrative action in an application for licensure, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) for having a license revoked, and pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) and 27-1-15.6-17(a) for failing to timely disclose an administrative action while previously holding Indiana nonresident licensure.
