ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq., and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to Craig Lavelle Walters ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

- Respondent is a licensed resident independent adjuster holding license number 993303 ("Respondent's license") since October 23, 2014.
- 2. Respondent's license expired on November 30, 2020, due to Respondent failing to renew it.
- 3. On August 31, 2020, Respondent was issued a Cease-and-Desist Order and Notice of Suspension and Fine by the Louisiana Department of Insurance, due to Respondent making misrepresentative or fraudulent statements and using coercive tactics in the course of insurance business wherein Respondent's resident independent adjuster license

- was suspended for six (6) months effective thirty (30) days from issuance of the notice, and fined one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).
- 4. The administrative action taken by the State of Louisiana was not reported to the Department by Respondent until October 5, 2020.
- 5. Respondent failed to timely report the Louisiana administrative action, which involved a license suspension, to the Department.
- 6. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(8) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an independent adjuster's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of insurance business.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(9) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an independent adjuster's license for having an insurance license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
- 8. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(2) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an independent adjuster's license for violating an insurance law, a subpoena, or an order of the Commissioner or another state's insurance Commissioner.
- 9. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-22(a)(1), which is an insurance law that states, that an independent adjuster shall report to the Commissioner an administrative action taken against the independent adjuster in another jurisdiction not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.

10. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew an

existing license, the Commissioner shall notify the Respondent, in writing, advising of

the reason for the nonrenewal. This Order serves as that notice.

11. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-28-

18(c), Respondent may, not more than thirty (30) days after receiving notice of the

Commissioner's notice of refusal, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a

hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held

within twenty (20) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

12. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned

authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of

Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to

preside over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more

information to begin the administrative process.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies

Respondent that Respondent's license shall not be renewed due to Respondent's administrative

action that resulted in a license suspension and for Respondent's failure to timely report said

administrative action from another state.
