PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Adebola Titilola Akadiri ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant applied for an Indiana nonresident producer license on or around March 2, 2021.
- 2. Applicant disclosed that on or around June 6, 2006, she was convicted of Possession/
 Distribution Controlled Paraphernalia, a Class 1 Misdemeanor, in the State of Virginia.
- Applicant disclosed that on or around March 31, 2008, she was convicted on two (2) counts
 of Possession of a Schedule III Controlled Substance, a Class 1 Misdemeanor, in the State
 of Virginia.
- 4. Applicant disclosed that on or around March 9, 2009, she was convicted of Destruction of Property, a Class 6 Felony, in the State of Virginia.

- 5. Applicant disclosed that on or around February 24, 2010, she was convicted of Identity Theft, a Class 1 Misdemeanor in the State of Virginia.
- 6. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 9. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to Applicant's aforementioned criminal history, including her felony conviction.
- 10. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
- 11. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to

preside over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more information to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to Applicant's criminal history, which includes a felony conviction. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
