PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Becky Beasley (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant submitted an application for a resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on July 30, 2021.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or

demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

5. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) & 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to Applicant's criminal history, which includes an August 2, 2000 conviction for Check Deception, a Class A Misdemeanor, and for failing to disclose the same, as well as, failing to disclose her pending charge of Theft, a Class A Misdemeanor, on her application for licensure.
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
7. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more information to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) & 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to her criminal history and for failing to disclose the same. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
