PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

4. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to Applicant's criminal history, which includes a December 17, 2014,

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the

conviction for Theft, a Class A Misdemeanor, from Maryland.

Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of

the Commissioner's action.

6. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned

authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of
