- 4. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-

15.6-12(b)(6) due to her November 22, 2002 conviction for Forgery, a Class C Felony, out

of the State of Indiana.

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three 5.

(63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the

Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of

the Commissioner's action.

This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned 6.

authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of

Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to

preside over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more

information to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to Applicant's felony conviction. Applicant

may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
