## PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Sarah Emerson ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant submitted an application for nonresident insurance producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on September 24, 2021.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue a producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to Applicant's, July 23, 2013 Disbarment by the Supreme

Court of Washington, for failing to deposit her clients monies into her trust account and

using those funds for her own purpose.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written

demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the

reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

6. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned

authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of

Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to

preside over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more

information to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Codes § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to Applicant's Disbarment by the Supreme

Court of Washington. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date

of this order.
