PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-27-7.1, hereby gives notice to Przemyslaw Majewski ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for nonresident public adjuster certificate of authority with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on February 12, 2022.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-27-3 and Indiana Code § 27-1-27-7.1.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-27-7.1(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue a public adjuster's certificate of authority for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-27-7.1(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue a public adjuster's certificate of authority for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or

demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility, in the conduct of

insurance business.

5. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant in support of his

application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not

fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-27-7.1(b)(1) and 27-1-

27-7.1(b)(8) by failing to disclose an administrative action taken by his home state for

demonstrating lack of fitness or trustworthiness while conducting the duties of a public adjuster.

6. Indiana Code § 27-1-27-7.1(c) provides that the applicant may, not more than thirty (30) days after

notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a

hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

7. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose

to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently,

after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of

Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over

this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to

Indiana Code § 27-1-27-7.1(a)(1) due to the nature of Applicant's administrative action and his failure to

disclose the same, by his home state of Illinois. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1)

year from the date of this order.
