PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Trevion Thornton ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order.

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for a nonresident producer license with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on or about July 19, 2022.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states in part, the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.

- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, materially untrue information in a license application.
- 5. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to Applicant having and failing to disclose his April 13, 2022 license revocation in Louisiana and October 11, 2021 license denial in Kansas.
- 6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
- 7. This is considered an agency action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the admirative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), due to Applicant having and failing to disclose his April 13, 2022 license revocation in Louisianan and October 11, 2021

license denial in Kansas on his application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
