PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Desmond Tanner Boone (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant submitted an application for a nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on November 22, 2022.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

4. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to Applicant's failure to disclose the following:
 - a. An October 11, 2019, administrative action in the State of Missouri resulting in a monetary penalty due to a misstatement on application;
 - b. An October 25, 2019, license denial due in the State of Indiana due to Applicant's failure to disclose his criminal history and administrative actions;
 - c. An April 10, 2020, administrative action in the State of Louisiana resulting in a monetary penalty, due to failing to failure to report administrative actions; and
 - d. An October 2, 2020, license surrender in the State of North Carolina due to failing to report administrative actions.
5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the Applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
6. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to Applicant's failure to disclose multiple administrative actions on his application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
