PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Eva Decire Gonzalez (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant was previously licensed in Indiana from September 3, 2019, until September 30, 2021 at which time, Applicant did not renew her license.
2. Applicant requested to reactivate her nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on November 23, 2022.
3. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
4. While previously licensed, Applicant failed to timely report the February 23, 2021 license denial from the State of New York for demonstrating lack of fitness or trust.

5. Applicant failed to disclose two (2) administrative actions on her November 23, 2022 application. Applicant did not disclose the February 23, 2021 license denial from New York or Applicant's July 18, 2022 license revocation from the State of Louisiana for failing to report an administrative action.
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, providence, district, or territory.
8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for violating an insurance law.
9. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(a) states that a producer shall report to the Commissioner any administrative actions taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.
10. Following a review of public records and a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A), and 27-1-15.6-17(a) due to her failure to timely disclose her New York license denial while an active

producer, failure to report two (2) administrative actions on her application for licensure, and for having a licenses denied and revoked in other jurisdictions.

11. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
12. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A), and 27-1-15.6-17(a) due to Applicant's failure to timely report an administrative action, failure to disclose on two (2) administrative actions on her application for licensure, license denial, and license revocation. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
