PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Alexander Ortiz (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application (“Application”) for nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on December 6, 2022.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) authorizes the Commissioner to refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) authorizes the Commissioner to refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
5. Following a review of public records and a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his Application, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as state by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), due to Applicant's failure to disclose on his Application a May 18, 2017 administrative action from the North Dakota Insurance Department that resulted in a license revocation and an October 25, 2021 administrative action from the Kansas Insurance Department that resulted in a license denial.
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
7. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to Applicant's failure to disclose a license revocation and denial. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
