PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Walker Spriggs ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on March 28, 2023.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to

Applicant being convicted on July 11, 2022, of Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, a Level 6 Felony, and Resisting Law Enforcement, a Level 6 Felony, in the State of Indiana and convicted on February 8, 2021, of Possession of Cocaine, a Level 6 Felony, in the State

of Indiana.

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three 5.

(63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written

demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the

reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you 6.

choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions.

Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, The

State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an

administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information

from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to Applicant's felony convictions. Applicant

may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
