## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq., and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Hannah Holley ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Respondent is a licensed nonresident insurance producer holding license number 3711859 ("Respondent's license") since August 20, 2021.
- 2. Respondent's license expired October 31, 2023.
- Respondent did not disclose Respondent's April 6, 2017 Misdemeanor conviction for Possession of Marijuana, on Respondent's August 19, 2021 initial application for licensure.
- 4. On or about August 17, 2022, Respondent submitted an application for additional qualifications.

- 5. On said additional qualification application Respondent failed to disclose Respondent's April 6, 2017 conviction for Possession of Marijuana, a Misdemeanor and an August 11, 2022 administrative action from the State of Ohio Department of Insurance resulting in a penalty due to nondisclosure of criminal history.
- 6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer's license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew a license, the Commissioner shall notify the Respondent, in writing, of the reasons for the nonrenewal. This Order serves as that notice.
- 8. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty-three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.
- 9. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **Respondent's license shall not be renewed** due to Respondent's failure to disclose criminal history on two applications and failure to disclose an administrative action on one application.
