

**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Sara Cutshall (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:


1. Applicant submitted an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on February 22, 2023.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met

the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to Applicant's failure to disclose the following multiple pending charges from September 26, 2022, for:

- a. Dealing in Methamphetamine/Amount of 10 or more grams, a Class 2 Felony;
  - b. Possession of Methamphetamine Possession of 28 or more grams of methamphetamine, a Class 3 Felony;
  - c. Maintaining a Common Nuisance - Controlled Substances, a Class 6 Felony;
  - d. Possession of a Controlled Substance-Possession of a Schedule I, II, III or IV, a Class A Misdemeanor; and
  - e. Possession of Paraphernalia a Class C Misdemeanor
4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the Applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
5. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, The State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to Applicant's failure to disclose her multiple pending criminal charges on her application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
