**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to Crystal Lynn Alston-Bayton (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:


1. Applicant submitted an application for a nonresident independent adjuster licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on April 18, 2023.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-28-17 and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18.
3. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6) due to Applicant’s February 25, 2015, convictions for Obtaining Money or Property by False Pretense in an amount greater than \$200, a Class U Felony, in the State of Virginia.; and

Computer Fraud; Obtain Property or Services in the amount of \$200 or more, a Class 5 Felony, in the State of Virginia.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that the Applicant may, not more than thirty (30) days after notice of refusal of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6) due to Applicant's felony convictions. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
