PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to Daniel Oldenettel ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for a nonresident independent adjuster license with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on July 18, 2023.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-28-17 and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(1) provides, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to issue an independent adjuster license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6) provides, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to issue an independent adjuster license for having been convicted of a felony.

- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(9) provides, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to issue an independent adjuster's license for having an insurance license, or its equivalent, refused in another state, province, district, or territory.
- 6. Following a review of public records and a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of Applicant's application, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-28-18(b)(1), 27-1-28-18(b)(6), and 27-1-28-18(b)(9) due to Applicant's April 3, 1998 felony conviction for forgery, severity level 8, nonperson felony, and theft, severity level 9, nonperson felony in Sedgewick County, Kansas; Applicant's May 3, 2011 license denial from the Kansas Department of Insurance; and Applicant's failure to disclose both the convictions and the denial on Applicant's July 18, 2023 application.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that Applicant may, not more than thirty (30) days after notice of denial of the application is received, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
- 8. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-28-18(b)(1), 27-1-28-18(b)(6) and 27-1-28-18(b)(9) due to Applicant's felony convictions, license denial in another state, and failing to disclose felony convictions and license denial on the application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
