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MOTION TO VACATE SUSPENSION ORDER

The Indiana Department of Insurance Enforcement Division (“Department”), by counsel, Joseph Bossinger, now moves for the Suspension Order issued January 4, 2024 in this matter be vacated. In support of this request, the Department states the following:

1. On September 13, 2023, the Ohio Department of Insurance issued an order revoking Respondent’s resident producer license.
2. On September 15, 2023, Respondent timely appealed the Ohio Revocation Order.
3. On October 5, 2023, the Common Pleas Court of Franklin County Ohio granted Respondent’s Motion for Stay of the Revocation Order, which stays the Ohio Revocation Order pending final resolution of the appeal.
4. On January 4, 2024, the Department issued Findings of Fact and Suspension Order (“Suspension Order”) suspending Respondent’s Indiana nonresident insurance producer license for failure to maintain licensure in good standing in Respondent’s home state.
5. As of the date of filing, the appeal remains ongoing.

6. On or around January 18, 2024 the Department verified through the Ohio Department of Insurance that Respondent maintains an active home state license.
7. The Suspension Order issued on January 4, 2024 was issued in error. Respondent remains in compliance with Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-8(f).

WHEREFORE, the Department respectfully requests the Suspension Order be vacated and all other relief just and proper upon the premises.
