PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Beverlyn A. Everage ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant was previously licensed as a nonresident producer from October 24, 2017, to June 30, 2020, at which time Applicant failed to renew.
- Applicant submitted an application for nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on October 6, 2023.
- 3. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.

- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
- 6. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to Applicant's failure to disclose the following administrative actions on the October 6, 2023 application:
 - a. A June 9, 2017, consent order from the Georgia Office of Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner due to Applicant's failure to disclose their criminal history;
 - A September 2, 2021, administrative order with a monetary penalty from the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation for a misstatement on their application;
 - c. A November 24, 2021, license suspension from the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation for failing to pay state taxes; and
 - d. An October 4, 2022, license revocation from the Louisiana Department of Insurance for failing to report another state's action.

7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written

demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the

reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

8. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you

choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions.

Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, The

State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an

administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information

from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to Applicant's failure

to disclose four administrative actions, including a license revocation and suspension, on their

application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the

date of this order.
