PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Rex Edward Smith ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on October 27, 2023.
- Applicant disclosed two Class D Felony Child Molesting convictions from December 1,
 1995 in the state of Indiana.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or

demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct

of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

5. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by the Applicant, the

Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not

fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6)

and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to the nature of Applicant's felony convictions.

6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written

demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the

reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

7. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you

choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions.

Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, The

State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an

administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information

from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to Applicant's criminal history. Applicant

may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
