**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND  
NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE**

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Arthur Walsh (“Respondent”) of the following Administrative Order:


1. Respondent is a licensed nonresident insurance producer holding license number 3519731 (“Respondent’s license”) since February 6, 2020.
2. Respondent’s license expired on March 31, 2024.
3. On March 15, 2022, the Washington Office of the Insurance Commissioner fined Respondent two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) for failing to timely report a November 2, 2021 Indiana Department of Insurance administrative action.
4. Respondent reported the Washington Office of the Insurance Commissioner administrative action to the Department on April 20, 2022.

5. On July 8, 2022, the Louisiana Department of Insurance fined Respondent two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) for failing to timely report the Kansas Insurance Department administrative action against Seguro Medico, a nonresident producer organization for which Respondent was co-owner and the Designated Responsible Licensed Producer for.
6. Respondent reported the Louisiana Department of Insurance administrative action to the Department on November 28, 2022.
7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer license for violating an insurance law.
8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(a) is an insurance law that states, in part, a producer shall report to the Commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in Indiana not more than thirty (30) days after the final disposition of the matter.
9. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew a license, the Commissioner shall notify the Respondent, in writing, of the reasons for the nonrenewal. This Order serves as that notice.
10. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty-three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.
11. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to

preside over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more information to begin the administrative process.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **Respondent's license shall not be renewed** due to Respondent's failure to timely report two (2) administrative actions.
