PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq., and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Bradley James Peete ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on August 22, 2024.

- 4. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to Applicant's March 2, 2021, conviction for

Criminal Recklessness, a Level 6 Felony, in Lake County, Indiana under Cause Number

45G03-2004-F5-000187.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written

demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the

reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

6. This is considered an agency action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose

follow aforementioned to appeal this administrative action, please the

instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a

hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will

assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more

information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby

DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to Applicant's failure to provide

complete information as requested by the Department in the application process. Applicant may

reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
