ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND
NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Ashley Nicole Boyett (“Respondent”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent was issued nonresident producer license number 3824966 (“Respondent’s License”) on August 24, 2022.
2. Respondent’s License expired on June 30, 2025, pending review of a renewal application submitted on June 19, 2025, in which Respondent disclosed for the first time that on or about February 6, 2025, a criminal prosecution against Respondent was initiated for Grand Theft, a Third Degree Felony, in Pinellas County, Florida under cause number 24-11627-C-K (“Florida Felony Matter”).

3. Respondent provided a court document showing that Respondent entered into a pretrial intervention program on May 28, 2025, to resolve the Florida Felony Matter, which is set to run for a period of twelve (12) months.
4. Respondent failed to report the Florida Felony Matter to the Department not more than thirty (30) days after the initial pretrial hearing date.
5. The Louisiana Department of Insurance denied Respondent a producer license on August 18, 2025, for having participated in a pretrial diversion program pursuant to a felony charge.
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) states, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer license for violating an insurance law.
7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b) is an insurance law that states, in part, not more than thirty (30) days after an initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the Commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction.
8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
9. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew a license, the Commissioner shall notify the licensee, in writing, of the reasons for the nonrenewal. This Order serves as that notice.
10. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty-three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the

reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

11. This is considered an agency action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **Respondent's License shall not be renewed** due to Respondent's failure to timely report the initiation of a criminal prosecution against Respondent and for having a producer license denied in another state.

Purpose:

The purpose of this memo is to recommend that the Commissioner approve the attached Administrative Order and Notice of Nonrenewal, which denies a renewal application for a nonresident producer due to Respondent’s failure to timely report a pending felony prosecution and for having a license denied in another state.

Facts:

Applicant applied for renewal to be a nonresident producer on June 19, 2025.

Applicant was issued a license denial by the Louisiana Office of Insurance Regulation due to the applicant’s criminal history on August 18, 2025, after Applicant’s license with the Department expired.

Mitigating/Aggravating Factors:

The Enforcement Division concludes that nonrenewal of the Applicant’s license is warranted based on the Applicant’s failure to disclose a pending felony charge, failure to timely report that pending felony charge, and failure to report a license denial in another state while licensed.

Analysis:


Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) states, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer license for violating an insurance law.

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b) is an insurance law that states, in part, not more than thirty (30) days after an initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the Commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction.

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.

Recommendation:

We request that the Commissioner approve the attached Administrative Order and Notice of Nonrenewal of License, denying licensure based on the Applicant’s pending felony charge and the Applicant’s license denial in another state.
